Rules and Guidelines

- Personal / non-professional use of photography is permitted, only if conducted without disruption to the galleries or visitors, and with the safety of the artworks in mind. Press and promotional photography and filming are taking place on the premises. Attendance at the fair implies permission for your image to be used for non-commercial purposes (including media reports). If taking pictures in gallery stands, the photographer requires the permission of the gallerist. Art Basel Show Management reserves the right to decline entry of any device that does not clearly comply with this policy. - There is limited storage available for jackets, bags, backpacks, umbrellas, etc., at the coat check on a first come, first serve basis. Whenever possible, please leave students' belongings on the bus or at the school. Please refer to the section 'Rules for Visitors' online at www.artbasel.com/miami-beach/at-the-show
- Sketch pads are not allowed in the exhibition halls. Students are not permitted to sketch works in the aisles as they would obstruct the visitor flow.
- Absolutely NO TOUCHING works of art including any sculptures. Students must be carefully supervised and instructed never to touch any artwork.
- · Students should not sit on the floor or congregate in the lobbies. Seating is available in the central area of the show.
- · Groups should be mindful of other visitors and keep their voices to a respectable volume.
- No running, excess noise, or playing is permitted at any time at the show.
- No food, drinks, candy, or chewing gum are allowed within the halls. It is recommended to have lunch before visiting

- · If behavior is not in accordance with the rules above, an individual student or school group may be asked to leave Art Basel.

Chaperon Policy

The recommended minimum chaperon student ratio is 1:10. Chaperons must remain with their groups at all times during the visit. Group leaders and chaperons are encouraged to view the exhibition prior to visiting with their classes to familiarize themselves with the show and its exhibits.

Group Size

Groups are limited to 30 children. Time slots are allotted for this amount plus up to three chaperons.

Tickets

Chaperoned school group tickets are USD 20 per person, including teachers and chaperons. School groups are defined as grades K–12. College and university groups should purchase a University Group Ticket at USD 45 per person, available in the online ticket shop at artbasel.com/miamibeach/tickets.

Pre-registration is required for all school groups. Tickets can only be ordered via the online registration form for a specific time slot.

Onsite payment

- 1. Print your time slot confirmation.
- 2. Present the confirmation at the school group desk in the North Lobby of the Miami Beach Convention Center and pay for your group tickets, collect your tickets, and follow the school host's instructions.

Identification

School Group Tickets will be distributed to each school group member.

Chaperons must wear a name tag which also includes the name of the school.

DRIVING & DROP OFF/PICK UP INSTRUCTIONS

Drop Off and Pick Up Zone

There is a designated drop-off and pick-up zone for school buses on the east side of the Miami Beach Convention Center on Washington Avenue in front of Entrance East B. Buses are not allowed to unload at the Convention Center Drive entrances. No parking is allowed in the drop-off / pick-up zone.

Entry into Building

School groups should enter the Miami Beach Convention Center through the North Lobby, then proceed to the 'School Group Meeting Point' for a short briefing by a designated hospitality staff member.
